



## DARFUR : DON'T LOOK AWAY ! PROTECT THE PEOPLE OF DARFUR AND EASTERN CHAD !

In September 2005 world leaders made an historic commitment: the Responsibility to Protect. Leaders pledged to protect their citizens and to act under the UN if a government is unwilling or unable to fulfill its primary responsibility to protect its own citizens. Yet this historic commitment has been ignored. For over 4 years the people of Darfur have endured mass killings, rape and forced displacement.

To the UN General Assembly 2007:

We, the undersigned, are outraged by the human rights violations suffered by civilians in Darfur and Eastern Chad.

We therefore urge you to use your authority to:

- Demand that the Sudanese government, armed groups and Janjawid militia halt attacks against civilians and humanitarian agencies;
- Ensure and commit to the expeditious and full deployment to Darfur of the African Union-United Nations hybrid peacekeeping force.

Darfur has witnessed the worst human rights abuses imaginable. Act now and protect the people of Darfur and Eastern Chad.
